

Engaging Young Adults in the Clubhouse 2020

Dear colleagues,

We at Fountain House Gothenburg, together with Genesis Club and Fountain House New York, are proud to offer you a chance of participating in a one-week training on engaging young adults in your Clubhouse. This is a great opportunity to expand the outreach of your Clubhouse to an underserved group living with mental health issues, as well as a chance to refashion your Clubhouse for the future.

The workshop will be held in Gothenburg, Sweden, on May 11th – 15th, 2020 (Monday noon – Friday noon). Gothenburg is located on the west coast of Sweden – the far north coffee-loving country, famous for stylish design, ABBA, meatballs and furniture you have to assemble yourself 😊

We ask that a team of two (preferably one member and one staff) from your Clubhouse attend the workshop. Through structured discussions and presentations, colleagues will understand and acquire strategic ways to improve your Clubhouse, to better insure that young people with mental health issues successfully enter the workforce and become part of a healthy community.

Each team will return home with an individual plan, outlining how to revitalize your Clubhouse and increase membership by attracting young adults.

The fee for one team is 20 000 SEK (about € 2000) and includes all course material, accommodation, breakfast and a trip to Liseberg, the biggest amusement park in northern Europe. Each training opportunity has a maximum of six teams.

You will stay at a hostel nearby the Clubhouse, and will be sleeping in team-shared double rooms. If you have other requests regarding this, please let us know. Breakfast is served at the Clubhouse every morning. Unfortunately, our Clubhouse is not wheelchair accessible.
